NOTICE OF LODGING

Defendant Lisa Jackson, Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”), with this notice lodges with the Court a proposed consent decree. The proposed consent decree should not be signed or entered by the Court at this time. Pursuant to section 113(g) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(g), the consent decree is not final and cannot be entered by the Court until the EPA Administrator provides “a reasonable opportunity by notice in the Federal Register to persons who are not named as parties or intervenors to the action” to comment in writing upon the proposed decree. After a reasonable public comment period, the EPA Administrator and the Attorney General, as appropriate, must promptly consider any written comments received. Id. If the federal government elects not to withdraw or

withhold consent to the proposed consent decree, EPA will promptly file a motion that requests the Court to enter this Consent Decree.
